Some Sobering Statistics

- One workplace accident can cost up to \$1,000,000 in lost time, wages and medical expenses.
- In 2004, companies spent over \$1.5 billion in workers' compensation claims.
- A total of 1.3 million injuries and illnesses required time away from work beyond the day of the incident in 2003.
- The \$40 billion of direct costs from workplace injuries identified by the 2002 Safety Index produced \$80 billion to \$200 billion of indirect costs.

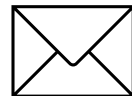

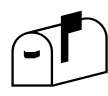
